PADI Open Water Scuba Certification Information

Welcome to the Pirates Cove Diving Inc. SCUBA Training Program. As the oldest diving store in Wisconsin we make every effort to offer friendly, safe and easy SCUBA Training. The following information will outline the steps to get the most from your SCUBA (Self Contained Underwater Breathing Air) experience.

- ❖ Course schedule: Students need to watch the online program or view the PADI DVD before starting the pool work. Most students need 3 to 4 pool sessions to master the PADI pool skills. Every student must have their own set of mask, snorkel, fins, and wet suit boots. On completion of the pool work, students need to schedule their open water dives (4 dives over 2 days). These dives are offered May through October from Pirates Cove.
 - Class assignments: Every student must view the PADI Video/DVD prior to class and bring their completed chapter knowledge review questions from their textbook. A quiz will be given each class to check your learning progress.
 - Medical condition: Scuba diving can be very easy and safe but your physical condition may impact on that safety. If, after viewing the PADI Medical Statement, you have any questions or concerns you must get the RSTC Medical Statement form and have it signed by your physician before class starts.
 - Individualized instruction: Everyone learns at his or her own speed. SCUBA Training requires every student to master many skills. To ensure the best possible results we will give any student all the (one on one) help they may require. On the other hand students that want to concentrate their training can work ahead.
 - ❖ Open Water Dives: The 4 open water dives scheduled over 2 days completes the final part of earning your PADI Open Water Diver Certification. These dives are from June 1 to Nov 1st. For an additional charge of \$150.00 the open water dives can be done any month in a dry suit. A pool orientation is necessary before use of the dry suit in open water. Several days before your scheduled dives you need to come to Pirates Cove Diving to be fitted with dive equipment. Times and location of the dives will also be confirmed. The open water dives must be completed within 12 months of your pool work.
 - ❖ Cost: The complete course, including pool training, dive computer use, and 4 Open Water dives is \$399.00. The PADI DVD is \$39.00 which can be returned after the pool work for a \$39.00 refund. Students may elect to pay for only class and pool, which is \$275.00. Open Water dives are then \$175.00 and must be completed within 12 months of final class/pool work. *Note, there is a cost savings when the complete course is paid in full within 3 weeks of the start of your class.*
