Starting your PADI Open Water Scuba Certification Program

The following information will outline the steps to get the most from your SCUBA (Self Contained Underwater Breathing Air) experience.

During these challenging time we are designing an easy way for you to complete the PADI Open Water Scuba Program. Here is the plan to easily get you through the class work before your pool training starts. *PLEASE do not hesitate to call your instructor or the dive store to answer any questions at any point during your training.*

- The first step is to go to the dive store- Pirates Cove Diving at 1103 W. Oklahoma Ave to pay for the Open Water Program and get your set of class materials. The store hours are Monday, Friday-11AM to 6PM; Wednesday, Saturday-11AM to 4PM.
- Begin by read the Introduction in the Open Water Diver Manual and do exercise 1-1 on page 19.
- Next read section one and do exercise 1-2 to 1-15, by now you should notice the answers for these exercise are below the questions, to check your own work. Now you are ready to do the Knowledge Review One on page 77. You can take a picture of your answers and text it to your instructor.

Continue reading sections two, three, four, and five, doing the exercises and Knowledge Reviews at the end of each and text them to your instructor.
